Community Cleanup Day set for Saturday, Oct. 22 in Twentynine Palms “Buck-A-Bag” sign-up forms available online

Community Cleanup Day is here again. On Saturday morning, Oct. 22, the City of Twentynine Palms and Burrtec Waste and Recycling Services will be sponsoring a free drop-off location for trash at the Community Services Center parking lot next to Luckie Park, 74325 Joe Davis Drive, in Twentynine Palms. The site will be open from 8 a.m. until Noon.

Items accepted at the cleanup site include household trash (no garbage), scrap metal, electronics, appliances, tires (limit of four rimless tires), and mixed recycling such as paper, glass, plastic, aluminum, and cardboard.

Residents with large loads, trailers, and green waste can drop off their trash free of charge on Saturday, Oct. 22 at the Twentynine Palms Transfer Station, 7501 Pinto Mountain Road, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Seniors and disabled customers of Burrtec who reside within the city limits may request curbside service for large or bulky items by calling (760)365-2015 at least one week prior to the cleanup day.

No hazardous waste will be accepted at the drop-off site. For items like motor oil, paint, insecticides, and household hazardous waste, contact 1-800-OILY-CAT (1-800-645-9228) for proper disposal.

As in the past, Community Cleanup Day will feature a “Buck-A-Bag” competition. Scout troops, school clubs, athletic teams, and community organizations are encouraged to participate. First, second, and third place winners will receive cash awards for their cleanup effort.

Groups can sign up in person at City Hall, 6136 Adobe Road, or by calling (760)367-6799 no later than Monday, Oct. 17. Team leaders can pick up designated trash bags and parking permits on Oct. 17, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Sign-up forms and rules are also available online at www.29palms.org.
