### **PLANNING COMMISSION AND CITY COUNCIL TO HOLD BACK-TO-BACK MEETINGS ON DEC. 15**

Tuesday, Dec. 15, will be a busy night at Twentynine Palms City Hall, as both the Planning Commission and the City Council are scheduled to hold back-to-back meetings in Council Chambers.

Beginning at 4 p.m., the Planning Commission will meet to review a Conditional Use Permit application for the proposed Hampton Inn and Suites, a member of the Hilton family of hotels. The facility plans to locate on 29 Palms Highway next to Marriott's Fairfield Inn and Suites, which opened last summer.

At 5 p.m. on Dec. 15, following the Planning Commission, the City Council will take over Council Chambers and hold its second regular meeting for December.

Two public hearings are on the agenda, dealing with Redevelopment Agency expenditures on the City's Visitor Center and an application from the Twentynine Palms Artists Guild for improvements to its historic building using RDA funds.

Bid awards will be announced for the multi-million-dollar Adobe Road project, which entails road reconstruction, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and bicycle path along Adobe between Amboy Road and the main gate to the Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center.

An update on Phase I of the Historic Plaza renovation project will include transfer of the City's Contractual Rights and Obligations with respect to Historic Plaza bid documents to the City Redevelopment Agency.

Also on the agenda will be a Redevelopment Agency annual financial report and a PE Consulting discussion on the City's upcoming solar project.

The public is invited to attend the Planning Commission meeting at 4 p.m. and the City Council meeting at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 15, at Twentynine Palms City Hall, 6136 Adobe Road. For more information, call 760-367-6799.

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
