Basketball

Youth Basketball League

This league is open to girls and boys that are enrolled in Kindergarten through 8th grades. Registrations begin the first week of November. Participants are not required to have experience in order to be placed on a team! The registration fee includes a uniform. Families with three or more children participating are eligible for a discount. The league will run from January to the end of February. Games are played weeknights and Saturdays. Outstanding athletes will be chosen from each team (not including Pee Wee divisions) to participate in the All Star Basketball Tournaments in March.

The Twentynine Palms parks and recreation department hosts an annual boys & girls all star basketball tournament held toward the end of each March. Teams from all over southern California compete against our local recreation program's all star basketball teams. Youth Soccer League

The recreation department will begin accepting registrations for the youth soccer league at the beginning of August. The season runs from September to mid-November. Children ages 4 through 14 are eligible to register. No previous experience is necessary! All children will be placed on a team regardless of their skill level. Games are played on Saturdays and weeknights. The registration fee includes a uniform which consists of a jersey, soccer socks and shorts. Parents must provide shin guards for all players. Soccer cleats are recommended! Picture packets are available for purchase during the season. An award ceremony for all players and teams will be held at the end of the season. Volunteer coaches and officials are needed in order to help us run a successful league. Families with three or more children participating are eligible for a discount.

Division II consists of 10 through 12 year old boys and girls. The registration fee includes a jersey. Awards will be presented at the end of the season. POOL Season

Open 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. weekends only beginning Memorial Day weekend, then open daily for the summer beginning the second week of June until the end of August.

Children in diapers must wear a waterproof covering. Life jackets are the only approved flotation device allowed in the pool. Lifeguards are on duty at all times. Appropriate swim attire must be worn. T-shirts, denim shorts, etc., are not allowed. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult. If your child does not know how to swim or is a weak swimmer, it is imperative that they are supervised by a capable adult. Please do not leave your children unattended at any time.

Our Parks

Luckie Park

Features four baseball fields, three covered picnic shelters, two playground areas, three basketball courts, a skateboard park, corn hole and horse shoe pits, a soccer field, and a pool. If you are planning a special outdoor event and want to reserve one of the covered picnic shelters, please contact the recreation office. Inflatable bounce houses are permitted, but must be insured. Special event liability insurance is available for purchase through the recreation office.

Knott's Sky Park

Is located off El Sol and Twentynine Palms Highway. The park features two little league fields, two playground areas, a covered picnic shelter and a large open grass field with horse shoe pit and A DOG PARK! The Old Schoolhouse Museum




